You will need:


















Step one:

Decorate the toilet paper roll. You could paint, colour, or wrap it coloured paper.



Step two:

With adult supervision, draw and cut out the butterfly wings.



Step three:

Colour, paint or decorate the butterfly wings



Step four:

Glue the wings to the back of the paper roll. Put your butterfly on the window sill and take a picture!
